## STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETING RECAP – MARCH 1, 2022

- I. <u>2:00 p.m. Call to Order</u>: Chairman Henderson called the meeting to order at 2:03 p.m. in the Assembly Room of the John P. Franklin Sr. City Council Building. A quorum of eight was present that also included Councilpersons Ledford, Hester, Berz, and Dotley. Councilwoman Coonrod arrived after the call to order. Deputy City Attorney Noblett and Council Clerk Gwyn were also present. Councilpersons Smith and Hill were not present at this meeting.
- II. Redistricting Committee Report: Councilwoman Berz made introductory remarks about the process for the ad hoc committee working on a redistricting recommendation. She then introduced Mr. Anderson, who gave a presentation titled "City Council of Chattanooga Redistricting" that included information on the requirements, process used, and proposed districts. Afterwards, Mr. Anderson, with assistance from Mr. Sevigny, responded to questions from the Council. After some discussion, Mr. Anderson agreed to change the language on the requirements slides regarding the "rule of 10-percent." Mr. Anderson also distributed proposed district maps to those councilpersons present. He noted that the proposed map was available now on the Open Data portal. The redistricting legislation will be readdressed at the first Strategic Planning meeting in April.
