## CHATTANOOGA CITY COUNCIL ELECTRONIC (VIRTUAL) MEETING STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETING <u>**RECAP**</u> – 08/18/20

- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: Chairman Henderson called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. via electronic (virtual) means. A quorum was present that included Vice-Chairman Smith and Councilpersons Berz, Byrd, Gilbert, Ledford, Mitchell, and Oglesby. Councilwoman Coonrod arrived at 2:28 p.m. Mr. Noblett was the assigned attorney. Council staff present was Ms. Gwyn and Ms. Christoph.
- II. <u>Paid Holidays Juneteenth</u>: Beverly Moultrie and Shea Jefferson gave a presentation on two options for adding a 12<sup>th</sup> paid holiday for employees and responded to questions on those options. After the presentation, Daisy Madison responded to questions on the cost for one paid holiday.
- III. <u>STVR Non-Owner Occupied</u>: Mr. Noblett informed the Council that he sent a draft to Councilwoman Coonrod that contained her changes. He then discussed the recommended changes: Zoning Review, designation of owner- and non-owner occupied, and primary residence for owner-occupied.
