AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING A TWENTY-FOUR INCH (24") SANITARY SEWER LINE AND SEVENTY-TWO INCH (72") CSO LINE EASEMENT ON PROPERTIES LOCATED IN THE 2800 BLOCK OF ASBURY PARK, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND AS SHOWN ON THE MAP AND DRAWING ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That there be and is hereby closed and abandoned twenty-four inch (24") sanitary sewer line and seventy-two inch (72") CSO line easement on properties located in the 2800 block of Asbury Park, more particularly described below and as shown on the map and drawing attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference:

Abandonment of a 24 inch sewer line being #50718 and a 72 inch CSO line located in the 2800 block of Asbury Park. Tax Map 155D-C-006.01, 006, 003, and 002.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two (2) weeks from and after its passage.
