ORDINANCE NO. 12367

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PART II, CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE, CHAPTER 18, SECTION 18-124, RELATIVE TO FEES FOR THE DUMPING BRUSH AND LEAVES, AND FEES FOR THE SALE OF WOOD CHIPS AND LEAF COMPOST.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 18, Section 18-124, be and is hereby amended by deleting same in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 18-124. Wood recycling and compost facility.

(a) Brush and leaves may be disposed of at the wood recycling and compost facility at no charge to City residents and at a rate of thirteen dollars (\$13.00) per ton for non-City residents, contractors, and persons-for-hire. The minimum charge for disposal of brush and leaves shall be six and 50/100 dollars (\$6.50.)

(b) Wood chips and leaf compost will be available at the wood recycling and compost facility during regular operating hours and subject to availability and reasonable operating restrictions that may be established by the Director. Fire wood is not available at the wood recycling and compost facility.

(c) City residents shall be entitled to five (5) no-charge loads of either wood chips or leaf compost per calendar year if hauled in a standard full size pick-up truck or single axle trailer without commercial tags.

(d) Non-City residents, contractors, and persons-for-hire may purchase wood chips and leaf compost at the rate of ten dollars (\$10.00) per ton. The rate for amounts greater than ten (10) tons shall be eight and 50/100 dollars (\$8.50) per ton.

(e) The Director may authorize delivery of wood chips at a market rate for hauling bulk quantity chips of fifteen (15) tons or more for not less than fifteen and 50/100 dollars (\$15.50) per ton.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two

(2) weeks from and after its passage but to be operative July 1, 2010.
