

RESOLUTION NO. 27225

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF THE CHATTANOOGA FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A 2012 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT ISSUED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY UNDER THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA), IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$108,972.00), AND AUTHORIZING A CITY MATCH OF TWENTY PERCENT (20%), OR TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR AND 40/100 DOLLARS (\$21,794.40).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the Chief of the Chattanooga Fire Department be and is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, accept a 2012 Assistance to Firefighters Grant issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security under the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), in the amount of \$108,972.00, and authorizing a City match of 20%, or \$21,794.40.

The Chattanooga Fire Department will request funding for 27 Masimo Rad-57 units which measure both oxygen and carbon monoxide in the blood. The request for the Assistance to Firefighter's Grant will be based on the grant priorities, and the award of any money will be managed to the standards presented in the grant guidance.
