

RESOLUTION NO. 27427

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF THE CHATTANOOGA FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT THE 2012-2013 CLEAN TENNESSEE ENERGY GRANT UNDER THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION (TDEC) FOR USE TO INSTALL GEOTHERMAL HEATING AND COOLING SYSTEMS IN TWO NEW STATIONS, STATION 9 (EAST LAKE) AND STATION 11 (HIXSON) TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION THIS YEAR, CITY FUNDS WILL HAVE A FIFTY (50%) PERCENT MATCH OF THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$32,760.00), FOR A TOTAL PROJECT COST IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$65,520.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the Chief of the Chattanooga Fire Department be and is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, accept the 2012-2013 Clean Tennessee Energy Grant under the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) for use to install geothermal heating and cooling systems in two new stations, Station 9 (East Lake) and Station 11 (Hixson) to begin construction this year, City funds will have a 50% match of \$32,760.00, for a total project cost in the amount of \$65,520.00.
