

RESOLUTION NO. 28032

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF KEVIN TAYLOR AS A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR THE CHATTANOOGA AREA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (CARTA), TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That KEVIN TAYLOR be and is hereby appointed as a special police officer for the Chattanooga Area Regional Transportation Authority (CARTA), subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties, except he shall not be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officer are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Parking Ambassador for CARTA, for the City of Chattanooga.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's employment by CARTA, for the City of Chattanooga. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
