

RESOLUTION NO. 29476

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF A 1999 THOMAS 77 PASSENGER SCHOOL BUS TO ERLANGER'S CENTER FOR EMERGENCY AND DISASTER MEDICINE SERVICES TO UTILIZE ON MASS FATALITY INCIDENTS OR MASS HOSPITAL EVACUATIONS, WITH AN APPROXIMATE VALUE OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-NINE AND 88/100 DOLLARS (\$100,549.88).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, it is hereby authorizing the donation of a 1999 Thomas 77 Passenger School Bus to Erlanger's Center for Emergency and Disaster Medicine Services to utilize on mass fatality incidents or mass hospital evacuations, with an approximate value of \$100,549.88.

The bus presently has 77,668 miles and has three (3) rows which include the following:

- Ambubus retrokit – allows eighteen (18) stretcher patients;
- Oxygen system – eighteen (18) flow meters;
- Two (2) Ambucarriers; and
- Two (2) Goto medical bags.
