A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SECOND AGREEMENT TO EXERCISE OPTION TO RENEW WITH THE CHATTANOOGA HOUSING AUTHORITY, IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE FORM ATTACHED, FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR THE USE OF THE SHEILA JENNINGS WELLNESS CENTER TO OPERATE PROGRAMS FOR YOUTH, YOUNG ADULTS, AND FAMILIES ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1201 POPLAR STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, that it is hereby authorizing the Mayor to execute a Second Agreement to Exercise Option to Renew with the Chattanooga Housing Authority, in substantially the form attached, for a term of one (1) year for the use of the Sheila Jennings Wellness Center to operate programs for youth, young adults, and families on the property located at 1201 Poplar Street.
