A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF

PHILLIP GRYMES, AS A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR THE MAYOR'S OFFICE IN THE

DEPARTMENT OF OUTDOOR CHATTANOOGA, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN, SUBJECT TO

CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That PHILLIP GRYMES, be and is hereby appointed as a special police officer for

the Mayor's Office in the Department of Outdoor Chattanooga, subject to certain conditions and

restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power

granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officer

of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties, except his duty shall not be

allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officer

are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Director of Outdoor

Chattanooga. The duties expressed are the ability to cite and enforce regulations in the city parks.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and

shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's

employment by the Mayor's Office in the Department of Outdoor Chattanooga. Notwithstanding

any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to

cancel such appointment at any time.
