

RESOLUTION NO. 30222

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA TO SERVE AS A GOVERNMENT SPONSOR AND PASS-THROUGH ENTITY FOR A GRANT FROM THE AMERICAN BATTLEFIELD PROGRAM, A PART OF THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, AND IN WHICH GRANT SHALL BE PASSED THROUGH TO THE AMERICAN BATTLEFIELD TRUST FOR WHICH IT WILL PURCHASE A 9.09 ACRE PARCEL KNOWN AS THE BROWN'S FERRY TAVERN TRACT (ALSO KNOWN AS THE CHAPIN TRACT) LOCATED IN THE CORE AREA OF THE WAUHATCHIE BATTLEFIELD IN HAMILTON COUNTY, FOR A GRANT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$259,446.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it hereby authorizes the City of Chattanooga to serve as a government sponsor and pass-through entity for a grant from the American Battlefield Program, a part of the National Park Service, and in which grant shall be passed through to the American Battlefield Trust for which it will purchase a 9.09 acre parcel known as the Brown's Ferry Tavern Tract (also known as the Chapin Tract) located in the core area of the Wauhatchie Battlefield in Hamilton County, for a grant amount not to exceed \$259,446.00.

The City is not providing any funds towards the battlefield acquisition.
