

RESOLUTION NO. 30969

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA TO SERVE AS A GOVERNMENT SPONSOR AND PASS-THROUGH ENTITY FOR A GRANT FROM THE AMERICAN BATTLEFIELD PROTECTION PROGRAM, A PART OF THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, TO BE PASSED THROUGH TO THE AMERICAN BATTLEFIELD TRUST TO PURCHASE A SEVEN POINT SIX (7.6) ACRE PARCEL KNOWN AS THE "BURNS TRACT" LOCATED IN THE CORE AREA OF THE CHATTANOOGA BATTLEFIELD, HAMILTON COUNTY, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO AND 19/100 DOLLARS (\$353,522.19).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the City of Chattanooga to serve as a government sponsor and pass-through entity for a grant from the American Battlefield Protection Program, a part of the National Park Service, to be passed through to the American Battlefield Trust to purchase a 7.6 acre parcel known as the "Burns Tract" located in the core area of the Chattanooga Battlefield, Hamilton County, for an amount not to exceed \$353,522.19.
