

RESOLUTION NO. 32110

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, TO ACCEPT THE COMMUNITIES SPARKING INVESTMENT IN TRANSFORMATIVE ENERGY (“C-SITE”) FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (“US DOE”) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,600,000.00), WITH NO CITY OF CHATTANOOGA MATCH; AND WILL PASS THROUGH THE FUNDS TO THE CHATTANOOGA HOUSING AUTHORITY (“CHA”) TO BE ALLOCATED FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE JAMES A. HENRY COMMUNITY CENTER FACILITY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to apply for, and if awarded, to accept the Communities Sparking Investment in Transformative Energy (“C-SITE”) funding from the U.S. Department of Energy (“US DOE”) for an amount not to exceed \$3.6 million, with no City of Chattanooga match; and will pass through the funds to the Chattanooga Housing Authority (“CHA”) to be allocated for improvements to the James A. Henry Community Center Facility.
